Study 2 (N = 256) experimentally manipulated two perspectives: a focus on feelings was expected to increase the framing effect; a focus on thoughts was expected to decrease it. Given men's lower emotional reactivity, we expected the affective focus would magnify framing effects among men, as they appear less likely to spontaneously consider how they would feel.
